**ADVERTISEMENT AND NOTICE FOR BIDS
(A16-0474)**

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, a Municipal Corporation, in the Council Chamber in the City Hall, 2201 University Boulevard, on the 22nd day of July, 2016, until 10:00, a.m., o'clock, local time, and then publicly opened and read for the furnishing of all labor and material (where required) and equipment for performing a project according to the plans, details, specifications and Contract Documents.

1. The Project:

A. The Project shall be known as the City of Tuscaloosa Seasonal Ice Rink 2016 and the general character of said project shall consist of the following:

Option A: Equipment rental, turnkey installation/removal, and professional support services of a 60'x100' outdoor, holiday-season ice rink within the City of Tuscaloosa, Alabama. To be open to the public for recreational ice skating and special events for eight weeks (November 30, 2016 until Jan. 16, 2017).

Option B [Alternate]: Equipment purchase and professional support services of turnkey installation/removal of a 60' x 100' outdoor, holiday-season ice rink within the City of Tuscaloosa, Alabama. To be open to the public for recreational ice skating and special events for eight weeks (November 30, 2016 until January 16, 2017).

B. The approximate quantities of said Project are as follows:

1. Professional Project Manager Assigned to the Event (advance coordination with Client, other primary vendors, timeline planning, coordination of installation, coordination of removal);
2. Pre-Event Design Services (including general overview layout of the Event Site, product specification information for each equipment item above, MSDS-specifications for all chemicals, other materials for Owner use for permits)
3. Pre-Event and On-Going Professional Support Services (including general guidance in the areas of liability-prevention, operational signing, programming, sponsorship benefits, day-to-day operating procedures, staffing, public safety)
4. 60'x100' ICEMAT-2 NEW Rink Piping Grid System
5. 200-Ton Air-Cooled Refrigeration System/Pumps/Hoses/Expansion Tank (SERVICED PRIOR TO SITE ARRIVAL)
6. Glycol Coolant Charge; Storage Containers; Transfer Pump (SET-UP TO CONTAIN AND MAINTAIN SPILLAGE)
7. Insulation and Vapor Barriers, As Required (INSULATION THICKNESS 3" OR MORE)
8. Modular Railing System—Clear Poly Facing For Logo/Graphic Placement
9. Ice Rink Maintenance Equipment: Mechanical Resurfacing Machine (ALLOWS A SINGLE PERSON TO SCRAPE, CLEAN, AND RESURFACE THE ICE WITHIN MINUTES) including replacement and maintenance parts if there is any failure of this equipment

10. Rental Ice Skates (350-pr.) Sharpened, Ready-To-Skate (specific sizes to be discussed with successful bidder)
11. Rubber Floor Covering for Skate Change Area (1,104-square feet)
12. All Professional Supervision and General Labor for Set-Up and Strike
13. Travel Expenses/Per Diem Expenses for Out-of-Town Professionals
14. Material Handling Equipment for Set-Up and Strike
15. All Tools, Equipment, and Supplies for Set-Up/Strike
16. Wood-Frame Covering Over Rink Header
17. Green Turf Carpet to Trim-Out/Finish Rink Perimeter/Edge
18. Refrigeration Technician On-Call 24-Hours During Entire Term
19. All Transportation and Freight from/to Factory/Storage
20. Liability-Limitation Package (including industry-standard text for liability waivers, yellow-jackets for skate monitors, text for various signing, text for P.A. safety announcements)
21. General Training for Rink/Event Manager Regarding Rink Operation
22. Commercial General Liability Insurance Coverage; Worker's Compensation Insurance Coverage; Automobile Liability Insurance Coverage, With Client As Additional-Insured Party, As Required

C. The City will furnish the following:

1. 3-phase, 480-volt, 600-amp continuous power supply to the refrigeration; Owner's electrician to connect Owner's side of service, on a timely basis; electricity consumption.
2. A level site required for footprint of ice rink area.
3. Continuous water supply available immediately adjacent to the rink area.
4. Use of an all-terrain forklift, with long-forks, during the installation and removal phases.
5. General security presence, 24-hours. Patrol Only
6. Coordination of all permits and licenses required for installation and operation of the equipment and venue; all communication with local authorities.
7. Kiosk or service counter for the ticket sale and skate rental operation.
8. Skate change deck area beside the rink with any other pedestrian access walkways into the rink area.
9. Sound/P.A. system for music entertainment and safety announcements.
10. All day-to-day management and operating staff, in uniform.
11. All signing and graphics, including operational signing and other signing for liability-prevention.
