**APPLICATION AND PERMIT FOR PARADE, PROCESSION  
OR ASSEMBLAGE UPON CITY STREETS**

**TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE, CITY OF TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA:**

Pursuant to Section 21-27 of the Code of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, application is hereby made to use the public streets or other public way or property of the City of Tuscaloosa for the purpose of a temporary parade, procession or assemblage as follows:

If yes, Permittee shall be responsible for complying with all ordinances, regulations, laws of the City of Tuscaloosa or the State of Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, including obtaining any applicable license. Neither the Permittee nor any person participating with it pursuant to this permit shall leave the permit area with any alcoholic beverage. Further, no minor under the laws of this State shall be permitted to drink or consume any alcoholic beverage in relation to this permit.
9. Any permit which will require the temporary closing of a public street shall be granted subject to approval by the Director of the City of Tuscaloosa Department of Transportation, which may provide barricades or other apparatus, as determined to be appropriate by the Department of Transportation and to temporarily close the public street from vehicular traffic. However, if the City elects not to do so, Permittee shall be solely responsible for blocking the street in a temporary manner so as to provide easy removal and access to the street for emergency situations. The assemblage on the City street shall remain open at all times to the general public.
10. Permittee shall not discriminate against any person because of race, color, sex, age, religion, disability or national origin, and shall further comply with all pertinent laws, ordinances and regulations of the City of Tuscaloosa, State of Alabama and the Federal Government.
11. Participants are not allowed to throw or distribute any items from floats or any location within the roadway. Permittee shall be responsible for removing all debris and litter caused by any activity pursuant to the issuance of this permit and if Permittee fails to do so, the City of Tuscaloosa shall have the right to remove such debris and litter and Permittee agrees to

and shall fully reimburse the City for the cost of clean up. Furthermore, Permittee accepts responsibility for any costs incurred by the repair or replacement of any City property damaged in connection with the issuance of this permit.

12. The City of Tuscaloosa reserves all of its rights and powers, neither abdicating, relinquishing, or waiving any of the same, including, but not limited to, its full and complete police powers. Permittee shall be responsible for providing for any and all security personnel. This permit is a mere license and as such confers no property rights upon Permittee. There shall be no third party beneficiaries to this permit.
13. This permit may be revoked immediately without notice by the City of Tuscaloosa, or the Chief of Police, if it is reasonably determined that the public health, safety and welfare necessitates such revocation.
14. In consideration of receiving this permit, Permittee agrees to release, remise and discharge the City of Tuscaloosa, its officers, agents and employees from any and all actions, sums of money, claims, suits, judgments, responsibility, or potential liability whatsoever which has or may in the future arise out of or be associated with any activity conducted pursuant to or otherwise related to said permit. Permittee further agrees to indemnify and forever hold harmless the City of Tuscaloosa, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, suits, judgments, responsibility or potential liability which has or may in the future arise out of any activity conducted pursuant to or otherwise related to said permit. Provided; however, this provision shall not apply to claims, etc., arising solely out of Permittee's assertion of constitutionally protected First Amendment rights.
