

## Eligibility for City Solid Waste Services

Residential - Single Family	A lot, property or parcel upon which is located a family unit or a house, building or structure or any multiple or combination of the same wherein there exists no more than three (3) family units which generate waste, trash, refuse and/or garbage.	Mandatory subscription to and participation in the weekly city garbage collection with the use of city regulated garbage carts is required.	Weekly city trash service is available for all city residential garbage customers, unless specifically denied for operational reasons. Participation in the city trash service is optional.	Weekly curbside recycling service is available for all city residential garbage customers, unless specifically denied for operational reasons. Participation in the curbside recycling is optional.
Residential – Multifamily (served by city garbage collection prior to 3/20/1997)	A house, building, structure, or any multiple or combination of the same on a premises, wherein there exists four (4) or more family units, <u>served by city garbage collection service prior to 3/20/1997.</u>	These properties may choose to stay with weekly city garbage collection service or use dumpsters provided by a commercial solid waste collection company. If city garbage collection is discontinued, the property will not be eligible for city garbage service in the future.	Weekly trash collection service is only available for residential multifamily properties that are active, current city garbage service customers, unless specifically denied for operational reasons.	Weekly curbside recycling collection service is only available for residential multifamily properties that are active, current city garbage service customers, unless specifically denied for operational reasons.
Residential – Multifamily Unit (not served by city garbage collection prior to 3/20/1997)	A house, building, structure, or any multiple or combination of the same on a premises, wherein there exists four (4) or more family units, <u>not served by city garbage collection service prior to 3/20/1997.</u>	These properties must use dumpsters provided by a commercial solid waste collection company. City solid waste collection services are not available.	These properties must use dumpsters provided by a commercial solid waste collection company. City solid waste collection services are not available.	These properties must use dumpsters provided by a commercial solid waste collection company. City solid waste collection services are not available. Tenants may use a city recycling drop off site for their recyclables.
Non-Residential	Any lot, property, building, premises or structure within the city generating garbage that is not a family unit or a multifamily unit as herein defined. Nonresidential premises shall include, but not be limited to, businesses, commercial establishments, public buildings, churches and nonprofit organizations, and any building or structure, or part thereof, used in connection with or for the foregoing, including the purpose of carrying on any business, trade, occupation or profession for which a business license is required by the city.	Non-residential premises are <b>REQUIRED</b> to use either the city garbage collection services or obtain a dumpster from a private solid waste collection company. Non-residential customers must meet certain eligibility requirements if they would like to use the city garbage collection service: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limited to 1 cart, picked up 1 time per week</li> <li>• Must comply with set out and removal times as well as placement requirements for garbage cart</li> </ul>	City trash service is not available non-residential premises. Bulky items and vegetative debris must be placed in a private dumpster or hauled to the appropriate disposal site.	Weekly curbside recycling service is available to non-residential city garbage customers only, unless specifically denied for operational reasons. Industrial / Manufacturing	Non-residential premises engaged in industrial or manufacturing concerns	Non-residential premises engaged in industrial or manufacturing concerns are not eligible for city garbage collection services and must obtain a dumpster from a private solid waste collection company.	City trash service is not available to non-residential premises engaged in industrial or manufacturing concerns. Bulky items and vegetative debris must be placed in a private dumpster or hauled to the appropriate disposal site.	City curbside recycling service is not available to non-residential premises engaged in industrial or manufacturing concerns. These establishments may use a city drop off location for their recycling.
