

**PUBLIC HEARINGS TO ACCEPT PROJECT & PROGRAM
PROPOSALS FOR THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S
2017 CDBG AND HOME PROGRAMS**

The City of Tuscaloosa will hold two public hearings to solicit recommendations from citizens, agencies and other interested parties for housing and community development projects and programs to be undertaken by the City with 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership funds. The public hearings will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Tuesday, January 10, 2017 and at 5:30 P.M. on Thursday, January 12, 2017 in the City Council Chamber in City Hall, located at 2201 University Boulevard.

The City will be submitting to the U. S. Department of Housing & Urban Development a One-Year Action Plan for Program Year 2017, the third year of its Five-Year Consolidated Plan for the Community Planning and Development Programs for Program Years 2015-2019.

Proposals may also be mailed to the City's Office of Federal Programs at P. O. Box 2089, Tuscaloosa, AL 35403, or delivered to the office, located on the 2nd floor of City Hall Annex No. I at 2201 University Boulevard. The Department must receive all proposals no later than 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, January 26, 2017. All project and program requests will be forwarded to the Mayor and City Council for their consideration for 2017 CDBG and/or HOME Program funding.
