Authority:

By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:


That William Snowden, Director, Office of Planning and Economic Development, is hereby directed to identify potential property for use as a research and technology park to be operated in conjunction with the University of Alabama, and/or any other institution of higher education in Tuscaloosa County. Mr. Snowden will also engage the Tuscaloosa County IDA and all other appropriate organizations/agencies in determining a location and the feasibility of this matter.

Mr. Snowden is to report his findings to the Mayor no later than June 1, 2010. His report will include, but not be limited to the feasibility of a research and technology park and sites identified for potential location.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this Order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This Order is not intended to conflict with, supersede, or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
