**Authority:**

By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:

That an Municipal Offenses Pre-Trial Diversion Task Force is hereby established to review feasibility of and provide guidance for implementation of a Pre-Trial Diversion Program for Municipal Offenses which are brought in Tuscaloosa Municipal Court. Members of the Task Force shall be as follows:


1.     Representative of the Office of the City Attorney
2.     Representative of the Human Resources Department
3.     Representative of the Tuscaloosa Municipal Court
4.     Representative of the Tuscaloosa Police Department
5.     Representative of the Public Defender's Office
6.     Representative of Private Criminal Defense Bar
7.     Representative of Bradford Health Services
8.     Representative of the Court Referral Office
9.     Representative of the University of Alabama
10.    Representative of Mayor's Office
11.    Representative of the Chair, Administrative Committee

The Task Force will meet as often as needed and may choose to organize and divide into subcommittees to tackle specific tasks as needed. Glenda Gamble shall serve as Chairperson of the Task Force and the Chairperson shall be responsible for submitting a report from the Task Force to the Mayor and Judge Hollingsworth by June 1, 2011, unless a further extension has been granted from the Mayor.

**Implementation:**

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this Order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This Order is not intended to conflict with, supersede, or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
