By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, and pursuant to the emergency powers vested in me as Mayor by Alabama State Law and the ordinances and resolutions of the City of Tuscaloosa, and including without limitation ALA. CODE §11-45-1, ALA. CODE §31-9-10, §9-3 of the Code of Tuscaloosa, the Proclamation of Existence of a Local Disaster And Emergency issued by me on April 27, 2011, and the resolution of the Tuscaloosa City Council adopted on April 27, 2011, and as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:


The ordinance adopted by the City Council of Tuscaloosa on August 9, 2011, titled AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TEMPORARY REBUILDING STANDARDS ON NEW CONSTRUCTION, AND TEMPORARY USE STANDARDS, IN CERTAIN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE CITY, is hereby ordered to be made effective immediately, by reason of this Executive Order, pending its publication.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This order is not intended to conflict with, supersede, or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not

create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
