Regarding: Municipal Building Security

Authority:

By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:


The responsibility for all municipal building security including staffing by Tuscaloosa Police Officers and Security Guards is hereby transferred to the City of Tuscaloosa Police Department.

The Chief of Police and/or his designees shall be responsible for proximity card access, inventory of keys to municipal buildings, decisions regarding security cameras and parking hang tags for employees and guests of designated municipal parking lots. Department Heads and employees are directed to cooperate with the Chief of Police and/or his designee in relation to the changes to municipal building security.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this Order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This Order is not intended to conflict with, supersede or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
