EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR

Executive Order Number: 2012-006

To: All Department Heads

Regarding: Expanded Role of Citizen Advisory Committee
 (A12-1510)

Authority:

By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:

1. Executive Order 2011-012 as amended created the Citizen Advisory Committee to review and comment on a proposed Comprehensive Plan for the large commercial and residential areas due for redevelopment. This Plan became known as the Tuscaloosa Forward Plan.


2. The Citizen Advisory Committee has completed initial work relative to the Tuscaloosa Forward Plan and the newly created MX and RX zones in the recovery area. The role of the Citizen Advisory Committee is hereby expanded to monitor progress and provide oversight of the residential and commercial construction in the newly created MX and RX zones through comment to the Mayor and Council. In addition, the Citizen Advisory Committee shall review and provide comment to the Mayor, Council and Planning Commission of any proposed changes to the MX and RX zones in the recovery area.

3. The Citizen Advisory Committee shall remain a ten (10) member committee with seven (7) members to be appointed by the Council and three (3) members to the appointed by the Mayor. All members shall serve at the pleasure of the Council or the Mayor.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this Order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This Order is not intended to conflict with, supersede, or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
