



District *Update*

It is truly an honor to work for the people of Tuscaloosa. In everything we do, our goal is to make a positive difference for the people of this great city.

To that end, I'm proud to give you an update on just a few of the projects that we are working on in Council District Five. I am limited by space in this letter; however, for a full update, I hope you will be able to attend our Mayor's Night Out Town Hall Meeting on Thursday, April 3 at Arcadia Elementary.

FIRE STATION FOUR - This \$2.5 million dollar facility is currently under construction, and with good weather, it should open in late 2014 or early 2015. The City is also adding an additional rescue unit at this location.

UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD BRIDGE OVER KICKER ROAD - This is an ALDOT project that has been accelerated for construction. The City has been advised that this project should begin in fall 2014. The construction window may last up to a year.

ALBERTA PARKWAY - This nearly \$8 million dollar infrastructure development is one of the primary projects the people of Alberta identified as a key component of recovery. When complete, it will fully upgrade water, sewer, storm and road infrastructure, plus add the City Walk from Jaycee Park to the Alberta School of Performing Arts. With rights-of-way still being acquired, it is likely this project will get underway in 2015.

JUANITA DRIVE - In an area that was absolutely leveled by the tornado of April 27, 2011, we have seen an amazing comeback thanks to resilient residents and our great partnership with Habitat for Humanity. To further enhance this comeback story, engineering is being completed on a storm water drainage project that will likely be a \$750,000 to \$1 million dollar investment. Construction will begin in 2015.

District Five is going see tens of millions of dollars in investments over the next 36 months. From the new technology library to the Jaycee Park improvements, including the new tennis facility, it is an exciting time to say the least.

Again, I hope you will be able to join us for the Town Hall Meeting. I know that Councilman Tyner, who is a tireless and effective advocate for District Five, will be joining me as we discuss the limitless future of our community.
