AMENDMENT #11 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the reallocation of funds within Round 4 and the allocation of funding in Round 5 in the amount of \$2,762,008. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$29,519,072 in projects will be funded.

In the Round 4 funding cycle, the Rosedale Phase III activity will be reduced by \$413,389 and reallocated to a new activity known as Street Reconstruction.

The Round 5 funding cycle will be created and the following funding amounts will be allocated to activities.

Street Reconstruction - \$1,962,008
Salvation Army – Center of Hope - \$500,000
Program Administration - \$200,000
Comprehensive Planning - \$100,000
