

## LEGAL NOTICE

### AMENDMENT #15 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the reallocation of funds within the Round 3, Round 4, Round 5, and Round 7 funding timelines as well as the creation of Round 8. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$32,868,972.00 in projects will be funded.

In the Round 3 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Alberta Technology Public Library activity by \$213,102.40  
Add The Salvation Army activity in the amount of \$213,102.40

In the Round 4 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Alberta Technology Public Library activity by \$426,565.18  
Reduce The Edge: Business Resource Center activity by \$40,000.00  
Reduce the Technology Infrastructure activity by \$324,284.61  
Add The Salvation Army activity in the amount of \$286,897.60  
Add the Alberta Parkway activity in the amount of \$503,952.19

In the Round 5 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce The Salvation Army activity by \$500,000.00  
Add the Alberta Technology Public Library in the amount of \$500,000.00

In the Round 7 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Alberta Parkway activity by \$503,952.21  
Add the Technology Infrastructure activity in the amount of \$324,284.61  
Add the Alberta Technology Public Library activity in the amount of \$139,667.60  
Add The Edge: Business Resource Center activity in the amount of \$40,000.00

Create a Round 8 funding cycle and allocate funds as follows:

Allocate \$400,000.00 to the Comprehensive Planning activity  
Allocate \$200,000.00 to the Program Administration activity
