

## LEGAL NOTICE

### AMENDMENT #13 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the reallocation of funds within the Round 2 and Round 4 funding timelines. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$29,769,072 in projects will be funded.

In the Round 2 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Technology Infrastructure activity by \$282,826.82  
Reduce the Alberta Technology Center activity by \$426,565.18  
Reduce The Edge: Business Resource Center by \$40,000  
Allocate \$749,392 to the Rosedale Phase III activity

In the Round 4 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Rosedale Phase III activity by \$749,392  
Allocate \$282,826.82 to the Technology Infrastructure activity  
Allocate \$426,565.18 to the Alberta Technology Center activity  
Allocate \$40,000 to The Edge: Business Resource Center
