Sealed proposals will be received by The Salvation Army, until 2:00 P.M., Thursday, October 2, 2014, for the New Center of Hope for The Salvation Army at The Salvation Army Main Office, 1601 University Boulevard East, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, at which time and place they will be publicly opened.

**ONLY GENERAL CONTRACTORS THAT HAVE BEEN PREQUALIFIED ARE ELIGIBLE TO SUBMIT BIDS.**

A cashier's check or bid bond payable to The Salvation Army in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the bidder's proposal. Performance and Payment Bonds and evidence of insurance required in the bid documents will be required at the signing of the Contract.

Nonresident bidders must accompany any written bid documents with a written opinion of an attorney at law licensed to practice law in the bidder's state of domicile, as to the preference, if any or none, granted by the law of that state to its own business entities whose principal places of business are in that state in the letting of any or all public contracts.

Bid documents may be obtained from Tuscaloosa Blueprinting & Reprographics, 1926 University Boulevard, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, upon deposit of \$250 per set, which will be refunded in full on the first two sets issued to each General Contract for submitting a bond fide bid, upon return of documents in good condition within ten days of bid date. Other sets for contractors, and sets for dealers, may be obtained with the same deposit, which will be refunded as above, less cost of printing, reproduction, handling, and distribution.

Bid bonds are to be issued by an acceptable bonding company licensed to do business in the state, with a Power of Attorney, to confess judgment thereon, with the understanding that the bidder shall not withdraw his bid for the guarantee period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids; that if his bid is accepted, he will enter into a formal contract with the Owner, and that in the event of a withdrawal of said bid within said period, or the failure to enter into said contract within the time specified, the bidder shall be liable to the Owner for the full amount of the bid guarantee as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, forfeit or as a penalty.
