

**PUBLIC HEARINGS TO ACCEPT PROJECT & PROGRAM COMMENTS FOR THE CITY OF  
TUSCALOOSA'S PROPOSED DIASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN**

The City of Tuscaloosa will hold two public hearings to receive comments and /or concerns from citizens, agencies and other interested parties for housing and other community development programs and projects to be undertaken by the City with Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Funds (CDBG-DR).
