By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:

That a Task Force is hereby established for the review of the responses to the City's Request for Proposals for a Downtown Hotel and Civic Center on the CityFest and/or Hotel Block at the intersection of Greensboro Avenue and University Boulevard. The Task Force will be chaired by Robert W. Ennis, City Attorney and will consist of the following: Mayor Walter Maddox, Council President Harrison Taylor, Councilwoman Cynthia Almond, Councilman Bobby Howard, William Snowden, Planning Director, Joseph Robinson, City Engineer, Mike Wright, Finance Director, Thomas Bobitt, Associate City Attorney, Robin Edgeworth, Legal Affairs Administrator, (All Department Heads may designate additional staff as needed.)

The purpose of the Task Force is to review and comment upon the responses to the RFPs from the interested parties, to meet with the interested parties and make recommendations thereon to the full Council.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this Order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This Order is not intended to conflict with, supersede or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
