Authority:

By the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama, including but not limited to Ala. Code §11-44B-7 (1975), pursuant to which the Mayor of the City as the Chief Executive Officer has the general supervision and control of all other officers and the affairs of the City, except as otherwise provided by law, I, Walter Maddox, as Mayor do hereby order and direct as follows:

That a Task Force be established to investigate possible consolidation of City payrolls. This Task Force shall investigate pros and cons of combining all payrolls as well as the frequency of payrolls. Members of the Task Force shall be either the department head or a representative from the following departments:


Human Resources
Finance
Tuscaloosa Department of Transportation
Environmental Services Department
Facilities Maintenance
Office of the City Attorney
Water Distribution

A chairperson shall be elected by those persons comprising the Task Force. A written report of findings and recommendations shall be submitted to me no later than July 31, 2007.

Implementation:

All Departments of the City and their respective employees to whom this Executive Order applies shall forthwith implement the same in accordance with its terms and requirements. Nothing contained in this order shall relieve a person from any requirement to obtain a license or other authorization in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This order is not intended to conflict with, supersede or contradict any lawful ordinance or resolution duly enacted by the City Council. This Order does not create any right, benefit, or privilege, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by a party against the City, its departments, agencies, entities, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
