AMENDMENT #18 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the creation of Round 11 which will be considered a substantial amendment. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$43,932,000.00 in projects will be funded.

Create a Round 11 funding cycle and allocate funds as follows:

Allocate \$878,412.76 to the Program Administration activity
Allocate \$66,903.24 to the Comprehensive Planning activity
Allocate \$119,400 to Small Business Revitalization Loan activity
Allocate \$1,314,109.37 to The Edge: Business Resource Center activity
Allocate \$39,576.67 to the Alberta Technology Public Library activity
Allocate \$611,272.57 to the Hargrove Road/Hackberry Lane activity
Allocate \$93,018.09 to the University Place/Forest Lake activity
Allocate \$27,468.25 to the McFarland Boulevard/15th Street activity
Allocate \$2,364,755.22 to the Alberta Parkway activity
Allocate \$177,452.59 to the PARA – Jaycee Park activity
Allocate \$1,031,209.24 to the Technology Infrastructure activity
Allocate \$454,000 to the 10th Avenue activity
Allocate \$1,937,992 to the Street Reconstruction Phase II activity
Allocate \$200,000 to the Alberta Park activity
