AMENDMENT #14 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the reallocation of funds within the Round 3 and Round 4 funding timelines as well as the creation of Round 7. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$32,268,972.65 in projects will be funded.

In the Round 3 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

- Reduce the Alberta Parkway activity by \$900,000
- Reduce the Fire Station #4 activity by \$117,687.24
- Reduce the McFarland Boulevard/15th Street activity by \$38,761.90
- Allocate \$63,513 to the IT Server Room activity
- Allocate \$530,141.41 to the Harmon Park activity
- Allocate \$200,000 to the Prince Avenue activity
- Allocate \$262,794.73 to the Technology Infrastructure activity

In the Round 4 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reallocate \$413,389 from the Street Reconstruction activity to the Technology Infrastructure activity

Create a Round 7 funding cycle and allocate funds as follows:

- Allocate \$1,900,000 to the Alberta Parkway activity
- Allocate \$61,138.75 to the Harmon Park activity
- Allocate \$38,761.90 to the McFarland Boulevard/15th Street activity
- Allocate \$500,000 to the Prince Avenue activity
